Scenario:

On 9-8-2019 at 0837 hrs., Officer Ketchum responds to a hit and run call. The victim states his parked vehicle (a 2015 dark green Ford Taurus) was struck while he was at work on the midnight shift. A neighbor witnessed the incident and described the vehicle as a red Buick driven by a white male in his upper thirties. After taking the report the officer drives around the neighborhood and finds a 2011 red Buick LaCrosse exhibiting damage consistent with the hit and run accident four blocks away. He also observes multiple empty beer cans on the floor boards. The vehicle is registered to the below listed suspect who lives a half mile from the Buick's location.
