NOTICE OF DFS POLICY CHANGE

To: All Law Enforcement Agencies served by DFS From: Linda Jackson, Department Director

Date: May 6, 2021

RE: New Packaging Requirements for Firearms and Ammunition Submissions

Recently, cartridges (ammunition) packaged with a firearm accidentally discharged while being transported at DFS. Cartridges pose a potential danger when packaged with the firearm or packaged in a manner that does not prevent the primer from being struck by another object.

Effective immediately, due to safety concerns, DFS will no longer accept evidence packages that contain both a firearm and ammunition/cartridges.

In order to submit cartridges for a comparison examination, package the firearm and cartridges in separate rigid or padded containers. It is not necessary to submit cartridges for NIBIN or Function exams. It is acceptable to leave cartridges in a magazine, packaged in a separate container from the firearm.

If cartridges are being submitted for DNA or Latent Print exams, package them separate from any firearm in a manner which best preserves that type of evidence.
