The largest metal bullet fragment contained in Item 5, disclosed the presence of general rifling characteristics consistent with having been fired through a rifled barrel with six (6) lands and grooves, direction of twist could not be determined. This bullet fragment is consistent with the class caliber of .25, which includes six (6) and seven (7) millimeter (mm) rifles. The fragment, Item 5, may have sufficient individual microscopic markings suitable for comparative examination and identification with the firearm through which it had been fired. This type of rifling characteristics is one of the most common encountered, therefore, it is not possible to list the firearms which may have fired Item 5.
