RESULTS OF EXAMINATION:

- Item #1 - Stains recovered from the head of the wrench were identified as human blood. Further tests indicate the blood is type A.
- Item #2 - Stains recovered from the head and the handle were each identified as human blood. Further tests on each indicate the type A Hp2-1 RAP-CB EsD-1.
- Item #3 - Tests on stains from the blade of the knife indicate the presence of human blood type A Rh positive Hp2-1 RAP-CB EsD-1.
- Item #4 - Tests on stains recovered from the handle of the screwdriver indicate the presence of human blood type A Rh positive RAP-CB EsD-1.
- Item #5 - Tests on stains on the watch indicate the presence of human blood type A Rh positive Hp2-1 RAP-CB EsD-1.
- Item #6 - Tests on stains on the can were identified as human blood type A DEce Hp2-1 RAP-CB EsD-1.
- Item #7 - Stains on the front of both legs and some stains on the back were identified as human blood. Further tests on these stains indicate the type is A DEce Hp2-1 RAP-CB EsD-1.
- Item #8 - Tests on stains on the pillow indicate the presence of human blood type A DEce Hp2-1 RAP-CB EsD-1.
- Item #9A- No evidence of blood was found in or on the knife pouch.
- Item #9B- Blood stains were noted on the watch band. Further tests indicate the blood is human in origin, type A Hp2-1.
- Item #10- Stains were noted over the front and both sleeves. Further tests on these stains indicate the presence of human blood type A DEce Hp2-1 RAP-CB EsD-1.
- Item #11- Stains were noted over the front of the T-shirt. Further tests indicate the presence of human blood and the type is A DEce Hp2-1 RAP-CB EsD-1.
- Item #12- The glasses were stained with human blood. Further tests indicate the blood is type A Rh positive Hp2-1.
- Item #13- Stains on the shirt were identified as human blood. Further tests indicate the blood is type A DEce Hp2-1 RAP-CB EsD-1.
- Item #14- Blood stains were noted over all the blue jeans.
- Item #15- A small amount of blood was noted on the sock.
- Item #16- No examination conducted.





In 2005, Governor Mark R. Warner ordered a review of all Department of Forensic Science serology case files worked between 1973 and 1988. The review was ordered because it was discovered that during that period, certain serology examiners had been affixing portions of tested swabs and cuttings to analytical worksheets that subsequently were retained in the official case file folders. These case files were kept, as all case files continue to be kept, in a secure, controlled environment within the Department's facilities until they were transferred to the State Records Center for long-term retention.


The specific purpose of the review was to locate files that contained evidence possibly suitable for DNA testing, in cases in which a listed suspect was convicted of a crime or crimes associated with the incident investigated. Verification of conviction information for named suspects was obtained in most cases with assistance from the Virginia State Police, the respective Clerks of Court and/or the respective Commonwealth's Attorneys. Federal grant funds and other funding were obtained to allow DNA testing, which was not available when the cases were previously examined, to be conducted on the evidence identified in the relevant files.

The laboratory case file with the above-referenced DFS laboratory number is a case submitted from your jurisdiction that lists at least one named suspect and was found to contain human biological evidence believed suitable for DNA testing. The evidence was sent to the private laboratory that the Department engaged for DNA testing. The test data was analyzed by the Department of Forensic Science and is reported in the attached Certificate of Analysis.

The enclosed report may state that a named suspect either can or cannot be eliminated as a contributor of DNA on a specified item of evidence. Any such information should not be regarded as dispositive evidence of a suspect's guilt or innocence but, rather, as a finding that suggests further investigation may be warranted.
