- Item 1 Spermatozoa heads were identified in stains on the towel. No evidence of blood was found.
- Item 2 Tests on stains on the towel indicate the presence of human blood type O Rh positive RAP-B Rsd-1.

RESULTS OF EXAMINATION:

- Item 1 Spermatozoa heads were identified in stains on the towel. Further tests on these stains indicate the secretions are type B. No evidence of blood was found.
- Item 2 Tests on stains on the towel indicate the presence of human blood type O Rh positive EAP-B EsD-1-Hp2-1.
- Item 3 Blood was identified on the washcloth. It was not possible to determine the type.
- Item 4 Blood was identified in several stains on the towel. It was not possible to determine the type.
- Item 5 Tests on stains on the scatter rug indicate the presence of human blood type O Rh positive EAP-B EsD-1. It was not possible to determine the type in the Hp system.
- Item 6 Tests on stains on the gold rug indicate the presence of human blood type O Rh positive Hp2-1. The amount was insufficient for further typing.
- Item 7 Tests on a stain in the front center of the shirt indicate the presence of human blood type O. The amount was insufficient for further typing. Tests on three (3) other stains on the shirt (one on the right sleeve, one at the bottom of the front at the right, and one (1) on the left sleeve) indicate the presence of human blood type B Hp2-2 in each.
- Item 8 No evidence of blood was found on the knife.
- Item 9 The panties were cut up on one side, ripped on the other and three (3) slits were noted in the back. Several blood stains were noted on the inside. Tests on these stains indicate the presence of human blood type B EAP-BA. It was not possible to determine the type in the other systems.
- Item 10 Blood stains were noted on both sides of the pillowcase. Tests on these stains indicate the presence of human blood type O Rh positive EAP-B EsD-1. It was not possible to determine the type in the Hp system.

- Item 11 Tests on stains on the underwear indicate the presence of human blood type O Rh positive EAP-B EsD-1. It was not possible to determine the type in the Hp system.
- Item 12 Tests on three (3) separate areas of the shirt (the right sleeve, the left front near the bottom, and the left front at the top) indicate the presence of human blood type O Rh positive EAP-B EsD-1 in each. It was not possible to determine the type in the Hp system.
- Item 13 Stains on the cigarette were identified as human blood. It was not possible to determine the type.
- Item 14 The sample contained two (2) pieces. Tests on stains on each piece indicate the presence of human blood type O Rh positive EAP-B EsD-1 Hp2-1.
- Item 15 Tests on eight (8) separate stained areas indicate the presence of human blood type O Rh positive EAP-B EsD-1 Hp2-1, in each. In addition, tests on another stain indicate the presence of human blood type B Rh positive EAP-BA EsD-1 Hp2-2. Tests on a tenth stain indicate the presence of human blood type A Rh positive EAP-B EsD-1. It was not possible to determine the type in the Hp system. In addition, spermatozoa heads were identified in another stain on the bedspread. Further tests on this stain indicate the secretions are type B.
- Item 16 Several stains on one side of the blanket were identified as blood. No other examinations were conducted.
- Item 17 Many stains on the blanket were identified as blood. No other examinations were conducted.
- Item 18 Tests on the stain on the pillowcase indicate the presence of human blood type O Rh positive EAP-B EsD-1 Hp2-1.
- Item 19 A small blood stain was noted on the pillow. No other examinations were conducted.
- Item 20 Tests on a stain on the pillow indicate the presence of human blood type O Rh positive Hp2-1. The amount was insufficient for further typing.

- Item 21** Tests on two (2) separate stains from the sheet indicate the presence of human blood type O Rh positive RAP-B RSD-1 Hp2-1 in each.
- Item 22** Tests on two (2) separate stains indicate the presence of human blood type O Rh positive Hp2-1 in each. It was not possible to determine the type in the other systems.
- Item 23** Blood was identified in two (2) stains on the rug. No other examinations were conducted.
- Item 24** A small blood stain was noted on the back of the cardigan. Tests indicate the blood is human in origin. The amount is insufficient for typing.
- Item 25 & 26** No evidence of blood or seminal fluid was found on either item.
- Item 27** Human blood was identified in stains on the side of the leg of the slacks. No other examinations were conducted.
- Item 28** A stain on the back of the trousers and two (2) stains on the front of the trousers were tested. These tests indicate the presence of human blood type O Rh positive in each.
- Item 29** Three (3) separate stains on the front of the trousers were tested. Tests on two (2) of these stains indicate the presence of human blood type O in each. Tests on the third stain indicate the presence of human blood type B Rh positive RAP-BA RSD-1 Hp2-2. Many other blood stains were noted.
- Item 30** No evidence of seminal fluid was found on the swabs or smears. No foreign hairs were found in the combings. Tests on the oral swabs indicate the secretions are type O.
